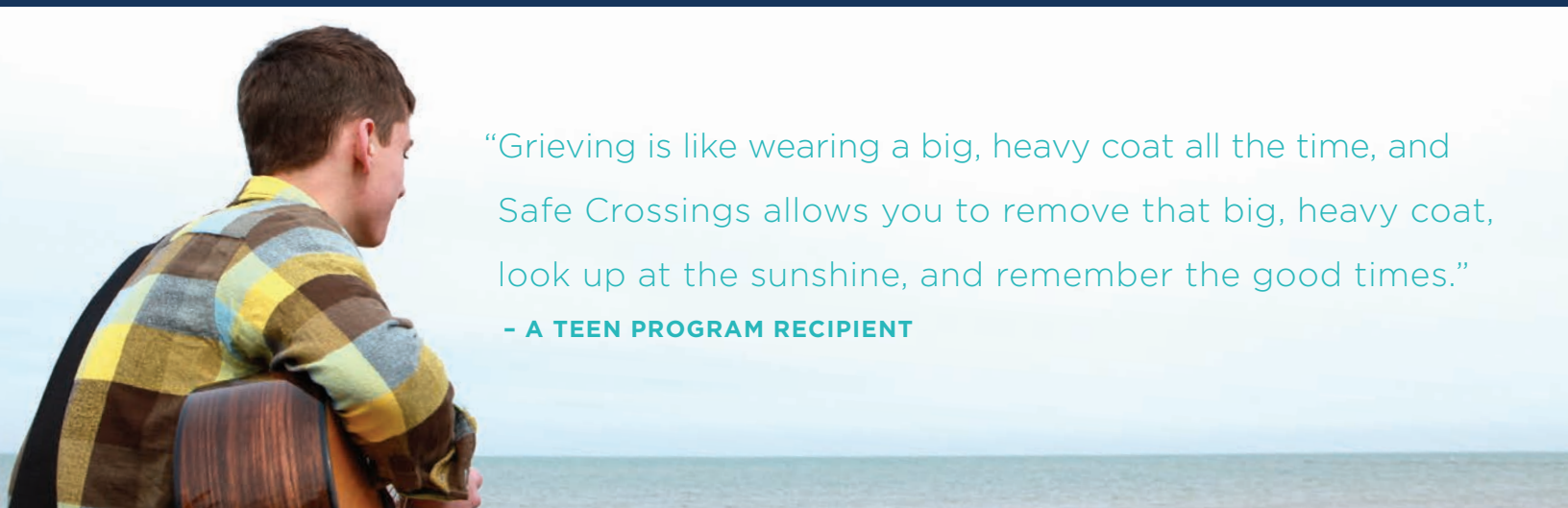

1 in 10 children will lose a parent or sibling before age 25. In the Puget Sound region, we could fill Century Link field with grieving children and still not have room. Such a death increases the risks of alcohol and substance abuse, anti-social behaviors, and high risk-taking activities, particularly for teens.

For 30 years, Safe Crossings Foundation has served as the only organization in Washington solely focused on children’s grief. By funding leading-edge grief recovery programs, Safe Crossings Foundation helps kids safely navigate loss, rediscover their joy, and emerge as emotionally healthy and resilient members of their families and communities.

Corporate sponsorship of Safe Crossings Foundation supports specialized counseling groups, in-home visits, art therapy, Camp Erin – King County, and other valuable programs designed to help thousands of young people and their families. For the last six years, we have also held an annual Northwest Conference on Childhood Grief for professionals in the field.
